

## 4.9 Corkboard, Chat



The Denali “Corkboard” is a simple application for posting messages and links –basically about anything. The format is very informal and is a bit like the electronic equivalent to the cork bulletin board in many business hallways – but this corkboard allows replies. Anyone can post to the corkboard, but their Directory name is used so hopefully add a measure or control. Replies also carry the users real name again as a measure of control over what types of things are posted.
